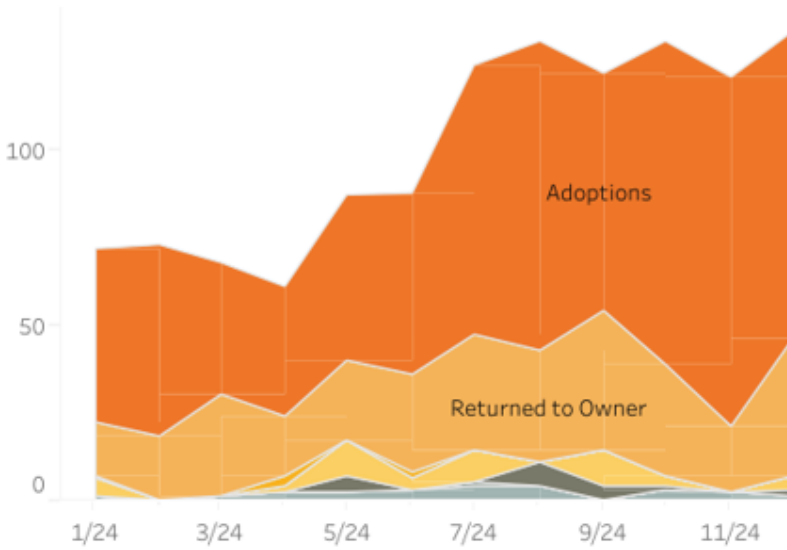

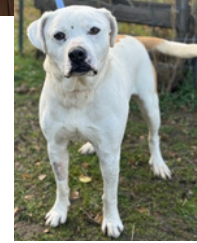

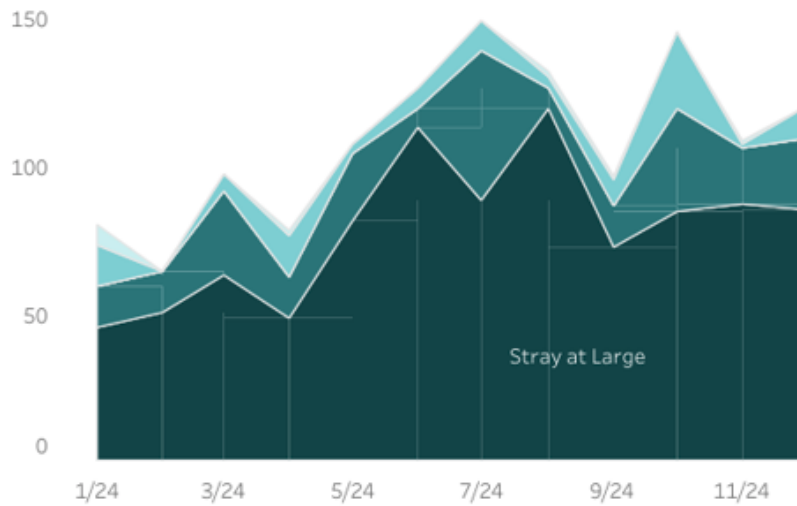
Gross Outcomes Details | 2024

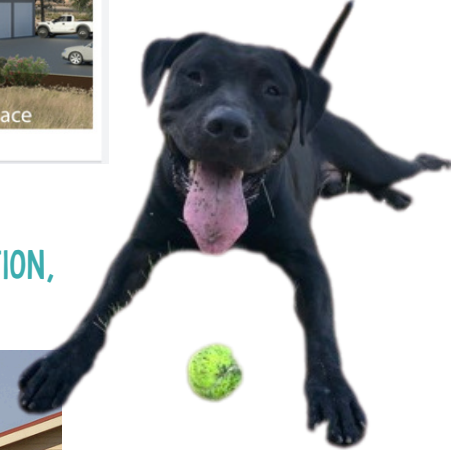
